TWENTY ACRES OF PURE *MAGIC*

Meadows, woodlands, stone circles, topiary gardens, parkland and sky. Every step reveals something new. Every season tells a different story. And every wedding here becomes a fairytale.

The land beneath your feet carries six centuries of extraordinary history. This estate was once held by Thomas Chaucer (c.1367–1434), son of the great poet Geoffrey Chaucer, Speaker of the House of Commons five times over, and one of the most powerful commoners in medieval England. In 1427, Thomas sold his half of the Gresham manor to the rising Norfolk lawyer Judge William Paston, a transaction that would ignite one of the most dramatic legal and military disputes of the age, immortalised in the famous Paston Letters.

The Paston Letters, England's earliest surviving collection of private correspondence, paint a vivid picture of what followed. Lord Moleyns disputed the Pastons' claim to Gresham, and in 1448 sent a force of over 1,000 men to seize it. Margaret Paston, alone in the fortified manor house, was forcibly ejected, the gates broken down, the house ransacked of £200 in goods, and the very door-posts cut through. It was an act of medieval lawlessness that shocked the nation and was recorded in letters that historians still study today.

Six hundred years on, the valley has returned to something quieter and more beautiful. The current owner, James Mermagen, farmed this land and transformed the working farmyard into the present buildings and gardens, where he lived for fifteen years before opening it as a wedding venue. He planted the trees, rewilded the valley, and watched nature reclaim what was always hers. Red Kites, Buzzards, owls, deer, hares, foxes and field mice have all returned. The same land that witnessed medieval siege and courtly intrigue now hosts the most joyful days of people's lives.





A HIDDEN GEM, WAITING TO BE YOURS

Tucked into a secret Norfolk valley, Chaucer Barn is not a wedding venue in any conventional sense. It is a living landscape, both wild and carefully tended, but utterly timeless. A home from home where the boundaries between celebration and nature simply dissolve. Here, you are not handed a package. You are handed the keys to something rare.

BACK TO NATURE

THE STONE CIRCLE

Our Stone Circle is a popular choice for more alternative ceremonies. Long before churches, and even before Stonehenge, stone circles across the British Isles were sacred places for marriage. Our magical circle has crystals buried under each stone and a huge 'Merlinite' crystal on the Druid's Portal at its centre. Inspired by Seahenge, the neolithic altar that emerged from the sands of the north Norfolk coast just 30 miles away.



THE WILDFLOWER MEADOW

The wildflower garden is your church in nature. You and your bridesmaids will process down the aisle through a garden of wildflowers, before walking through a tunnel of living willow to emerge on the lawn where your congregation awaits. Home to rare snakehead fritillaries and wild orchids, with red kites and buzzards circling lazily overhead, your ceremony takes place in a living, breathing cathedral.



THE TOPIARY LAWN

Formal and yet contemporary, the pyramid lawn is a favourite amongst couples, and their photographers! Like something out of Alice in Wonderland, the forest of 33 random pyramids makes a surreal frame to the traditional English garden of the pyramid lawn. Completely unique in the gardening world, this breathtaking installation gives a huge wow factor to your magical moment.

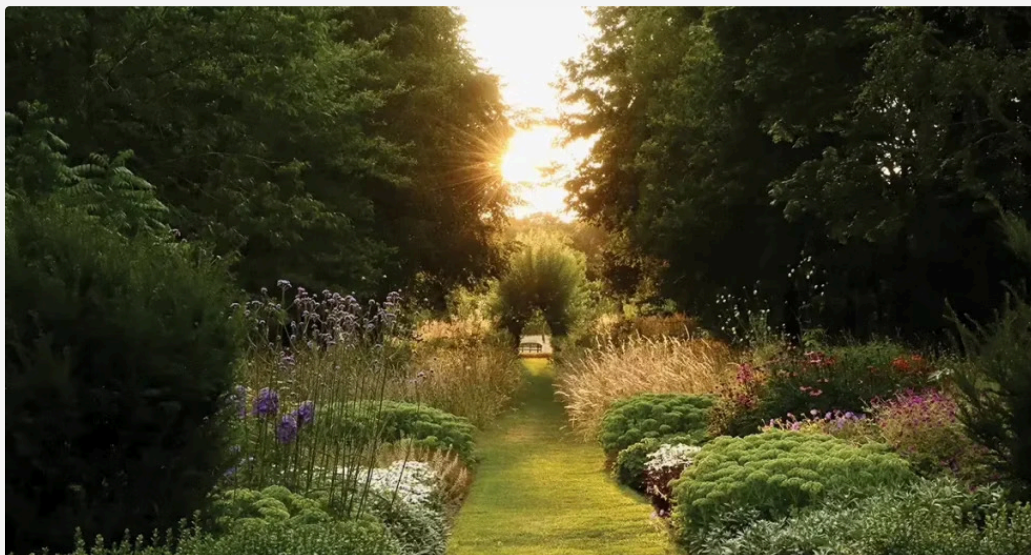


THE WOODLAND

Hiding on the far side of our re-wilded valley sits a magical woodland glade, tucked away at the bottom of a steep slope covered in trees and bluebells. After processing through the long grass and wildflowers of the valley, you and your bridesmaids will enter through a tunnel of wisteria into a secret and secluded woodland grove. In the bosom of nature, surrounded by towering trees, you will say your vows in front of a living willow tunnel covered in climbing flowers. Magic doesn't come any more natural than this!

PRICES

The Barn is hired as a dry hire venue with accommodation, licensed for Wedding celebrations. Inclusive of the hire, you have use of 9 bedrooms in the Barn, plus the option of an additional 5 Woodland Lodges. The accommodation is self-catered, giving you a blank canvas to choose your own suppliers or get creative and do it yourself. Our support includes assistance throughout planning, venue meetings as required, as well as event assistance for the ceremony and on the day venue duties. Those wanting a fully coordinated role have local supplier options for this.

We have a wealth of experienced local suppliers who come recommended and work regularly with us, but you can choose all suppliers to suit your wants and do as much or as little yourselves in creating a truly unique celebration.

Midweek hire is based on a 2-night minimum, and weekend hire is based on a 3-night minimum Fri–Mon, with the option of extending on these if you wish. The Barn is available for hire excluding or including the Woodland Lodges. Exclusivity of the land is only applied when Barn and Lodges are booked.
